The very good organization, together with the pleasant hospitality of the organizers has favoured the institution of friendly relationships among the participants with the possibility of realizing stages with Scientific Institutes associated to IAEG".



Scientific and professional debates on topics of engineering geology

Outstanding members of the association claimed presentations of specialty, from which we have selected: "The strategy further investigation for the deposits of radioactive waste of GEOTEC", "Engineering geology judgment in order to solve the problems of mining in IPROMIN", "Deformability of natural and improved loess deposits in the area of Cernavoda ", "Interpretation of the interaction loess - groundwater", "Stability of roads and rails in colapsibile lands", "Recent results in the study of landslides ", "New methods of stabilizing embankments by horizontal drains", "Engineering geology and natural heritage preserving", "Geological

engineering and hydrogeological characteristics of the territory of Bucharest", "Actual geological engineering problems of dams and hydroelectric power stations in Romania", "Geological engineering problems of the new designed highways in Romania", "Re-updating data of engineering geology - important contribution to assessment of the safety to earthquakes of hydrotechnical buildings" and others.

The President ARGI is a member of the IAEG Council, which governs and manages IAEG. In this capacity attended (by its own means) the majority of IAEG congresses every 4 years for the election of the President and of the Executive Committee and other IAEG annual meetings of the Council. The Romanian Group of engineering geology is part of the core of countries with continuous activity in the IAEG for more than 20 years and has had in the past few years, in particular by the efforts of the treasurer of the association, an ever-increasing

number of members contributors IAEG, with and without subscription to Bulletin of Engineering Geology and the Environment.

A part of ARGI achievements was presented to the IAEG Secretariat as contribution to mark in 2014 the anniversary of 50 years from the establishment of the International Association for Engineering Geology and the Environment (IAEG).

Revenue ARGI

They come from fees of members, from research contracts under the aegis of ARGI (where they exist) and, sporadically, from donations. Annual contributions of members cover partially expenses for bookkeeping (accountants' fees employee), maintenance website of ARGI and banking commission for the payment of national group contributions to IAEG, the remainder of the expenditure being covered from other sources.

Other expenses (derived exclusively from contracts ARGI, of the president, and to the greatest extent, of the treasurer) have been occasion by the sponsorship of speciality field activities of the students in engineering geology from the Faculty of Geology and Geophysics professor and by the sponsorship of scientific symposia carried out in cooperation with faculty or Geological Institute
